LSA Tips

What is LSA?



LSA is money available each fiscal year (1 Apr to 31 Mar) to help run the corps/sqn. LSA can be used to help pay for or buy things that cadets and staff may need for training, admin or support. Work in partnership with the Elemental Leagues/Support/Sponsoring Committees and Branches to take advantage of and use the LSA well! But remember, you can't buy things that the CAF provides.

Gather all the following documents:

- Signed LSA reimbursement letter
- Completed Excel LSA Tracker spreadsheet
- Copies of all bills, paid invoices, full receipts with date and items clearly visible
- Copies of payment confirmations such as cashed cheques, bank statements and credit/debit card receipts, etc.

Ineligible items:

- Assessment fees from or contributions to the
 - Provincial or National Leagues



- Items available through Regional Cadet Supply Group (ie. Tents, cots, sleeping bags etc.)
- Next to skin items (including unit t-shirts)
- Items purchased as gifts or give-aways such as mugs, flowers, trophies/plaques, etc.
- Desktop/laptop computers, tablets, monitors, docking stations, keyboards, mouse, cables, carrying cases, USBs, stands/risers, etc.
- Flight/ship simulators
- Network equipment such as routers, mobile internet devices, ethernet switches, etc.
- Printers, copiers and scanners including PC connected label makers
- Software, webcams, LCD projectors, TVs, videoconferencing systems and platforms, etc.
- Drones, Laser-based marksmanship and biathlon simulators
- NMMs or COVID-19 related sanitation supplies
